SPECIAL CALL MEETING MINUTES 10:00 AM on Wednesday, March 8, 2017

1. Roll Call

Mayor Christina Rosenthal called the meeting to order at 10:01 and announced a quorum was present. Mayor Pro-tem Butch Reis and Councilmembers Joan Hinshaw, and George French III were present. Councilmembers David Williams and James Bilberry were absent.

2. Invocation

Invocation was performed by Mayor Christina Rosenthal.

3. Pledge to the Flags

Mayor Christina Rosenthal led the pledges to the flags.

4. Business and Action Item(s):

A. Discussion and possible action on receiving bids and awarding sale of the City of Nolanville, Texas, Tax Note, Series 2017.

Chris Lane, City's Financial Advisor provided a summary of the bids received and recommended the City award bid to BB&T Governmental Finance.

Motion was made by Mayor Pro-tem Butch Reis to approve the Ordinance. Mayor Rosenthal requested the motion be rescinded (vote referenced item 4B). Motion was made by Councilmember George French III to rescind vote; second by Councilmember Joan Hinshaw. Motion Carried 3-0.

Motion was made by Mayor Pro-tem Butch Reis to approve the bids received an award sale of the City of Nolanville, Texas Tax Note, Series 2017 to BB&T Governmental Finance; motion second by Councilmember George French III. All voted in favor. Motion carried 3-0.

B. Discussion and possible action to approve Ordinance No. F 17-03:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF THE CITY OF NOLANVILLE, TEXAS, TAX NOTE, SERIES 2017; AUTHORIZING THE LEVY OF AN AD VALOREM TAX IN SUPPORT OF THE NOTE; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INVESTMENT LETTER AND A PAYING AGENT/REGISTRAR AGREEMENT; AWARDING THE SALE OF

THE NOTE; AND AUTHORIZING OTHER MATTERS RELATED TO THE ISSUANCE OF THE NOTE.

Clayton Chandler, Bond Counselor to the City from McCall, Parkhurst and Horton provided the completed ordinance to the City Council confirming the interest rates.

Motion was made by Councilmember Joan Hinshaw to approve Ordinance No. F 17-03; motion was second by Mayor Pro-tem Butch Reis. All voted in favor. Motion carried 3-0.
