

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-05-19 #8091

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF NOLANVILLE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE MAY 14, 2011, ELECTION BY CERTIFYING THE GENERAL ELECTION RESULTS; DECLARING THE RESULTS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2011-02-03 #8091 of the City of Nolanville, Texas, adopted on the 3rd day of February, a General Election was duly held on the 14th day of May, 2011, for the purpose of electing three (3) Council Members;

WHEREAS, said election was held with the solemnities and formalities necessary to make it a valid election, all notices having been posted in the manner and for the length of time required by law; and

WHEREAS, only duly qualified resident voters of the City of Nolanville, Texas, voted at the General Election called and held on May 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, section 67.003 of the Texas Election Code, as amended, generally provides that each local canvassing authority shall convene not later than the eleventh (11th) day after the General Election Date for the purpose of canvassing the election results; and

WHEREAS, section 67.004(a) of the Texas Election Code, as amended, establishes the quorum level required to canvass election results; and

WHEREAS, a quorum of the City Council met on May 19th, 2011, and duly canvassed the election returns of the above mentioned election, hereby attached as Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF NOLANVILLE, TEXAS:

Section 1. The findings set forth above are incorporated into the body of this resolution as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. That the City Council officially finds and determines an election was duly ordered to be held in the City of Nolanville, Texas on the 14th day of May, 2011, for the purpose of electing a Council Member for District 3 to serve the remainder of the unexpired term of office, and that proper notice of said election was duly given; that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election; that said election has been made and delivered; and that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns all in accordance with the law.

Section 3. That the City Council officially finds and determines that only qualified resident voters of the City of Nolanville were allowed to vote at said election, and the following votes were cast at said election, and that the canvass of the votes cast in said election and returns thereof, which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, were made in accordance with the law.

Section 4. Pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Texas Local Government Code, Texas Election Code, and the City of Nolanville, the City Council officially finds and determines and declares the results of the said election to be that;

SEAT #2 Councilmember

Sherry Morales is elected by a majority vote of the voters in the City of Nolanville as Seat #2 Councilmember for the term of two (2) years.

SEAT #4 Councilmember

Miguel Aviles is elected by a majority vote of the voters in the City of Nolanville as Seat #4 Councilmember for the term of two (2) years.

SEAT #5 Councilmember

Lacie Hicks is elected by a majority vote of the voters in the City of Nolanville as Seat #5 Councilmember for the term of two (2) years.

Section 5. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Resolution are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Resolution shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of the competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation of this Resolution of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.


Section 6. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.




